Principal's Fund	These are funds the PTA makes available to the school principal. They are most often used to
	supplement teacher training and as financial aid for field trips and/or summer school programs.
Recess Support & Training	These are funds to provide "training" to students on appropriate and good use of recess time.
"Specials" Support	Each year the PTA provides a specials team (Art, Music or PE) with additional funding to support their program. This has been used to buy additional art supplies, musical instruments, and PE equipment. It's also been used to purchase carpets for our music room and to paint logos in our gymnasium. In 2018-2019, we will fund the ART program.
Supplies/Class Supplements	The PTA reimburses teachers and other staff for classroom supplies that they would otherwise pay for out-of-pocket. Each teacher receives \$200 per year.
Teacher/Staff Appreciation	The PTA has a committee that organizes several staff appreciation events (breakfasts, lunches, etc.) for our well-deservering teachers and staff. This budget was increased to include the PEP staff and adding additional teacher appreciation events.
Technology Purchases	Over the years, the PTA has made several significant investments in the school's technology infrastructure.
Training & Teacher Support	These funds are used to help cover the cost of training and conferences for our teaching staff.
WAES Building Enhancements	This fund will pay for projects to enhance the new school. Proposed projects include water bottle filler fountains, an outdoor water fountain, hand dryers for the bathroom and a peace pole.
STUDENT ENRICHMENT	
Anthology	Cut from the Budget as the teaches do not have time to fit this activity into the schedule due to new curriculum.
Visiting Artists	The PTA contracts with authors, artists, and other professionals to supplement portions of the Curriculum 2.0 classroom experience for our students.
Cultural Arts	We help cover the cost of in-school assemblies.
ESOL	The PTA has a committee that organizes several events throughout the year in support of international families in our school community. These funds help support those events.
Financial Assistance	These are funds specifically set aside to provide aid to students otherwise unable financially to participate in a school program. For privacy reasons, the PTA does not administer these funds, which are run through the school's administration.
International Night	In alternating years, the PTA organizes a school-wide International Night in the spring (in odd numbered years). This is one of our most widely attended events. These funds support the entire event, including materials used in each country themed classroom. International Night will be held next in 2021.
Planetarium	The PTA supports the Planetarium Committee with funding to cover curriculum materials, and technology and other supplies.
STEAM Room	The steam room provides a creative space for students to work on projects in science, technology, engineering, art and math. These funds support supplies for the STEAM room, science kits and volunteer training.
Geography Bee	Wood Acres is planning to hold its first Geography Bee in FY19. The funds cover the costs of supplies and room rental.

This fund supports speakers on the topic of race and equity in our school and community. Budget increased this year at the recommendation of the committee chair
These funds support our annual Science Fair. The funds cover materials, room rental, student
recognition, and other event-related expenses.
In alternating years, the PTA organizes a school-wide Space Night in the spring (in even numbered
years). This is one of our most widely attended events. These funds support the entire event,
including materials used in each space themed classroom. Space Night will next be held in 2022.
The PTA has a committee that organizes several events throughout the year in support of families
with students in our special education program.
The PTA does not financially support the 4th Grade Wizard of Oz program, however, we do
administer the program and the funds for it, which are collected directly from the participants.
The WOZ committee did ask for funds from the upcoming budget to refresh the costumes.
This is a one-time expense
Each spring, the PTA organizes an Arts Festival to display the many artistic talents of our students.
These funds support the materials and activities that are associated with the evening event.
At the end of the school year, the PTA organizes an event at a Bethesda Big Train game. The Big Train
is our local collegiate summer baseball team. This line item covers the cost of game tickets for teachers and staff.
These are funds used for direct support of local community service activities.
The PTA gives a \$750 contribution each year to the 5th Grade Farewell Committee, which organizes
activities and gifts for 5th Grade promotion. In addition, the remainder of the funds from the
previous year's Wizard of Oz are included in the budget for the Fifth Grade Farewell. All other funds
for the farewell program are collected from fifth grade families.
The PTA purchases items (e.g., "Welcome to Wood Acres" pencils) to distribute to incoming
Kindergartners during the spring orientations.
We have a committee that organizes several events at the start of the school year for families new to
Wood Acres. This line item supports these events.
The funds support a back to school picnic at the beginning of the year.
This captures the donation that we make to our sister schools, New Hampshire Estates ES and
Oakview ES in Silver Spring. The amount of this line item is equivalent to the amount raised by our
Ledo's Pizza fundraiser.
While the PTA has a volunteer webmaster, this line covers the cost of additional website
maintenance and enhancements that are beyond the scope of our volunteer. Funds include support
for our new website from the website designer and potential ecommerce options.
Each year, all the elementary schools in the Whitman cluster make a donation to the Whitman Prom
After Party event (a post-prom, alcohol free event that runs through the night and is attended by
most prom participants.
New budget line item for this year. The PTA invited a few speakers to its general membership meeting in the Winter 2020 to discuss relevant topics parents and teachers face each day. The speakers were well received so the board decided to add it as a line item to the budget.

PTA SUPPORT Bank Charges	Occasionally, we are hit with bank charges for returned checks and other administrative fees. These
bulk charges	have become less frequent as we have moved most of our money collection online.
Insurance	The PTA is required to maintain a liability insurance policy for our Directors and Officers.
Other Administrative	This line item covers the cost of random supplies, our annual subscription for our online payment system, and other administrative costs.

President's Fund	This funding is available to the PTA Executive Committee to cover the cost of otherwise uncategorized expenses. Examples include "get well" gifts for staff and financial assistance for PTA-sponsored activities.
PTA Association Dues	These are payments we make to the Maryland PTA and the Montgomery County Council of PTAs (MCCPTA) for national, state and local membership dues. We pay these on a per member basis.
PTA Storage Unit	The PTA helps pay for a storage unit to hold materials for Space Night and the Wizard of Oz.
Tax Preparation/Audit	The PTA is required to have a financial audit conducted each year. We choose to have the audit and our annual tax filings prepared by an accountant.
Whitman Cluster Support	These are funds that we provide to support programs and advocacy in support of the entire Whitman cluster.
